Considered one of the top, if not the best, players in Augusta State Golf history ... The only three-time All-America selection in ASU history and the only Jaguar to be named to the first team ... Scored four individual tournament titles in his career, a school record ... Finished his stellar career owning four school records ... Career stroke average of 72.05 ranks second only to Jamie Elson (71.92) ... Comped in the 2003 Walker Cup following his senior season ... Part of victorious Great Britain and Ireland squad that defeated the United States 12.5-11.5 at Ganton Golf Club in North Yorkshire, England ... Posted a 2-0-1 record, including a key 1-up singles victory over American Bill Haas ... Also selected to the 2003 Palmer Cup's Great Britain-Ireland squad for the third straight year ... Helped lead GB&I to a 14-10 victory over the U.S.

As A Senior In 2002-03: Enjoyed one of the most successful seasons in Augusta State golf history ... A second-team All-America pick by PING/GCAA (Golf Coaches Association of America) ... Became the first three-time All-America selection in school history ... Also named an NCAA All-Independent first-team selection ... Captured a school-record three individual titles and led Augusta State to a school-record six team victories ... An integral part of ASU's rise to No. 2 in the national rankings ... Climbed to the top of *Golfweek's* collegiate rankings and enjoyed a two-week stint as the nation's No. 1 collegian after second win of the season at the Gator Invitational ... Finished the season as the nation's No. 12-ranked individual by *Golfweek* ... Led team with a 72.03 stroke average in 11 stroke-play events ... Carded 19 rounds of par or better, including nine rounds in the 60's ... Missed the season opener (Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate) to represent his home country at the Home Internationals ... Opened the fall with a third-place finish at the Carpet Capital Collegiate Classic ... Tied for 16th at PING/*Golfweek* Preview before garnering first victory at Duke Golf Classic ... Posted a 2-1-1 record in the Hooters Collegiate Match Play ... Delivered dramatic chip-in to defeat Clemson's Matt Hendrix 2-and-1 and give ASU a 3-2 victory over top-ranked Clemson in the finals of the Hooters Collegiate Match Play Championship on the Dye Course at Barefoot Resort in North Myrtle Beach, S.C. ... Victory over the Tigers propelled ASU to No. 2 national ranking, the highest in school history ... Earned second individual win at Gator Invitational ... Won his third individual title of the season at the Cleveland Golf/ASU Invitational at Forest Hills Golf Club ... Established a new school and tournament record by firing a three-round total of 17-under 199 ... Also set a new school mark with a final round of eight-under 64 that included a 14-foot eagle putt on the par-four, 290-yard 18th to clinch medalist honors and team title for ASU ... Set another school mark with a two-round total of nine-under 135.

As A Junior In 2001-02: As a junior, turned in one of the top seasons in Augusta State golf history ... A first-team All-America selection by the GCAA, the first Jaguar to earn first-team honors in program history ... Earned NCAA All-Independent Player-of-the-Year honors as well ... Posted a 71.77 scoring average over 34 rounds, the third-best single-season average in school history ... Led Jaguars to their best-ever showing at the NCAA Championships, a fifth-place finish at Ohio State Golf Club's Scarlet Course in Columbus, Ohio... Had eight top-20 finishes, including five top-fives and seven top-10s ... Carded a team-leading 17 rounds of par or better ... Fired a season-low five-under 65 during second round of Gator Invitational ... Shot season-low, three-round total of nine-under 207 at Cleveland Golf/ASU Invitational at Forest Hills Golf Club ... Finished a season-best third on three different occasions -- at the Cleveland Golf/Kiawah Island Classic, at the Duke Golf

Classic and at the Schenkel E-Z-GO Invitational.

As A Sophomore In 2000-01: A third-team All-America selection by the GCAA ... Palmer Cup participant along with teammate Jamie Elson ... Accounted for 1 1/2 of his team's 6 points ... Ranked 54th in the nation in the individual rankings ... Played in all 13 tournaments ... Posted a 72.36 stroke average ... Low round was a 65 (-7) ... Recorded four top-10 finishes and nine top-20 finishes ... Won the Cleveland Golf/ASU Invitational with a dramatic chip-in for eagle on the 18th hole to force an individual and team playoff ... Made a par to edge Wake Forest's Bill Haas as the Jaguars won the team playoff over North Carolina State.

As A Freshman In 1999-00: Joined the team during the spring semester of 2000 ... Posted ASU's second-lowest stroke average (72.49) ... Finished the season with four top-10 finishes and six top-20 finishes ... Notched 13 rounds of par or better, second-best total on the team ... Also had four rounds in the 60's.

HIGH SCHOOL: Played golf at Ashfield Comprehensive in Mansfield, England ... Finished third at the 1997 European Masters Tournament ... Led England to a third place showing at the 1997 World Boys Tournament in Japan ... Finished second at the 1997 European Boys Tournament.

PERSONAL: Born September 14, 1980 in Mansfield, England ... Majored in Psychology.
